QUICK GASES OPERATIONS - UPDATE

The Botswana Energy Regulatory Authority (BERA), wishes to inform the public that Quick Gases (Pty)Ltd has ceased trading in Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) pending the outcome of court processes relating to a matter of deceased estate. The Regulator therefore advises members of the public who currently hold empty cylinders belonging to Quick Gases to exchange them at the Quick Gases facility in Pilane (Plot 204 Bakgatla) or call them at +267 572 8217 / 505. This is a temporary measure only open to individuals and not retailers.

The Regulator in collaboration with the local gas companies is working around the clock to ensure that customers who hold Quick Gases cylinders are not adversely affected by the non-trading of Quick Gases.

Notwithstanding the absence of Quick Gases in the market, the Regulator wishes to assure the public that gas continues to be readily available in the market.
