INTRODUCTION OF BERA REGULATORY FEES

The public is informed that Botswana Regulatory Authority (BERA) will be introducing regulatory fees on the regulated services in the energy sector with effect from 1 September 2023. This is in line with the BERA Act sections 26 and 51.


The usage fees will be as follows:

- Electricity: 0.98 thebe per kilowatt-hour.
- Petroleum (diesel and petrol): 3.85 thebe per litre.
- Liquefied Petroleum Gas: 4.31 thebe per kilogram.

The application fees and other charges will be as follows:

- Electricity License Application fee: P1,000 to P30,000 depending on the size of plant or activity.
- Petroleum and Gas Application fee: P1,000 to P30,000 depending on the size of plant or activity.

The Authority will be explaining the details of this press release in the next month through various media such as radio, TV, social media, BERA website etc.
